In early March WSGC traveled to Greenville, NC, to attend the 26th annual Piedmont Invitational Children's Choir Festival. 165 young singers from 7 North Carolina choirs lifted their hearts and voices together in glorious song in the beautiful sanctuary of The Memorial Baptist Church. The final concert showcased each of the choirs performing individually, ending in a massed choir performance. The Festival Conductor was Emmy Williams Burch, the founder and artistic director of RISE Chorales, an organization built to create choirs that revolutionize and inspire singing excellence.

When I first dreamed of creating a festival to raise awareness of the Amani Children's Foundation here in Winston-Salem, I wanted to find a way that young singers could connect globally with other children in need. Amani supports New Life Homes in Kenya, which take in orphaned babies due to HIV/Aids and poverty. They nurse these precious babies back to health while seeking adoptive families, with many years of great success!

In 2010 we held a "pre-festival" event with composer/conductor Tom Shelton of Westminster Choir College. After learning about Amani, participants wrote about what they



learned. Tom, who quickly embraced the loving spirit of Amani, took their words and ideas and incorporated

them into our theme song, "Beyond Borders", now published by GIA Publications.



It was premiered in the fall of 2010 and is the culminating song in each festival concert.

On Friday, November 3rd, Tom returned to Winston-Salem to celebrate our **5th biannual Amani Festival Event** together with the High Point Young Voices. We visited



the Amani Village Market here in Winston-Salem and caught up with Amani co-founder, Jane Stephens (pictured above in front of the Maya Angelou Quilt), then joined our singers to begin rehearsals. The following afternoon featured a culminating concert which included a Love Offering for Amani to help support another orphaned baby.

Due to Kenyan elections this past fall and subsequent unrest, New Life Homes have been affected and need has increased. Even though our festival is complete, let us continue the spirit of Amani with our prayers and support. For more info: www.amanichildren.org.
